

Japan Society of Ski Sciences 35th Conference in PyeongChang, Korea

1. Main theme: “The Beginning of Academic Exchange in Skiing between Japan and Korea”

The main theme of the conference is “The Beginning of Academic Exchange in Skiing between Japan and Korea”. Japan Society of Ski Sciences was established in 1990, and to date it has accumulated a variety of research results, and in 2021 it published “The 100-Year History and Prospects of Ski Research”. In order to contribute to the further development of snow sports research in the future, we believe that international academic exchange with an eye on overseas countries is necessary. Therefore, at this academic conference, we would like to promote efforts towards the internationalization of the Japan Ski Society by promoting academic exchange with South Korea.

In South Korea, the 2018 Winter Olympics were held in Pyeongchang, and various snow sports were promoted and a lot of infrastructure was developed, but there are still many issues regarding the subsequent utilization of this. We would like you to experience first-hand how this “legacy” is being used.

The Yongpyong Resort is located in Pyeongchang-gun, Kangwon Province, in the east of South Korea, and is about 2 hours and 30 minutes away from Incheon International Airport via the airport railway and high-speed railway. For this conference, we will be traveling to the venue by chartered bus from Incheon International Airport. Starting with the pre-seminar on the Friday evening of our arrival, we have scheduled workshops, keynote lectures, symposiums, research presentations (posters), and workshops for Saturday, Sunday, and Monday.

The language used will be Japanese, and Japanese interpreters will be provided as necessary, so even if you are not proficient in Japanese, you can still participate with ease. We will announce the details as soon as they are finalized via our website, etc., so we look forward to your participation.

From Incheon International Airport, take the A'REX airport railway (approx. 60 mins) to Seoul Station, then take the KTX (Korea Train Express) (approx. 120 mins) to Jinbu Station. From Jinbu Station, take a taxi to the hotel.

On Friday, March 7th and Monday, March 10th, a chartered bus will run between Incheon International Airport (Terminal 2) and the Ramada Hotel & Suites Pyeongchang (in addition to the participation fee, a separate bus fee of 10,000 yen for a round trip and 5,000 yen for a one-way trip will be collected).
